A trio of accolades made for an exciting month at Glenwood Caverns Adventure Park

Doing the unexpected and a team effort to make its guests smile led to recognition for Glenwood Caverns

Adventure Park from Sunset magazine, TripAdvisor and Reader's Digest in July.

GLENWOOD SPRINGS, Colo. (Aug. 7, 2018) — The good news just kept coming in July as Glenwood Caverns Adventure Park was honored with a trio of accolades. Recognition from TripAdvisor, Reader's Digest and Sunset magazine made for an exciting month for the family-owned theme park in Glenwood Springs, Colorado.

"One of the things that we're known for at Glenwood Caverns Adventure Park is doing the unexpected—like bringing the first alpine coaster to the U.S. and building the world's first underground drop ride. We're not in a big city or on either coast, just tucked away on top of a mountain in a town of about 10,000 people," Nancy Heard, general manager for the Adventure Park, said. "So, when we are recognized alongside the Disneys and Universal Studios of the world, it's a big deal for us. We're the little theme park that could."

The online version of Reader's Digest, RD.com, with a reach of 19.1 million unique visitors per month, released its list of the top theme parks in each state on July 11. Glenwood Caverns Adventure Park received top honors for Colorado: "Top rated by TripAdvisor among Colorado amusement parks, Glenwood Caverns Adventure Park is America's only mountain-top theme park."



Sunset announced the winners of its Travel Awards in the August issue, which hit the newsstands in mid-July. The magazine, founded by the Southern Pacific Railroad to promote travel in the West, honors excellence and innovation in the tourism industry across the 13 Western states, British Columbia and Alberta. This year, the park's Haunted Mine Drop was named a finalist for Best Attraction.

Then, just 10 days later, the world's largest travel site, TripAdvisor, announced its top 25 amusement parks in the U.S. Glenwood Caverns Adventure Park came in at number 20 in excellent company. Other parks on the list include Magic Kingdom, Universal Studios, Disney's Animal Kingdom, SeaWorld, DisneyLand, Busch Gardens and Silver Dollar City.
