EXTREME ADVENTURES

One of the best things about Glenwood Caverns Adventure Park is that there's really something for everyone to enjoy. For our more adventurous guests, we offer breathtaking thrill rides and extreme caving expeditions. Liability waivers, which can be downloaded from glenwoodcaverns.com, are required for these attractions.

ADVENTURE TOUR

At the top of Iron Mountain, visitors can tour Glenwood Caverns and Historic Fairy Caves, recognized as offering one of the leading family cave tours in the country. Less strenuous than the Wild Tour but more challenging than the Cave Tour, this 90-minute guided tour allows cavers to explore new areas of the cave, visiting rooms filled with incredible formations. Total time required is 2 ½ hours to allow time to gear up and gear down before and after the tour. This is a moderately strenuous activity that includes belly crawling and squeezing through tight spaces. Protective gear and coveralls are available for rent. Reservations required.¹

ALPINE RUSH

Strap yourself into a seat on the Alpine Rush zip line and take a thrill ride 650 feet downhill, over the tree tops, at speeds up to 50 miles per hour. Enjoy beautiful views of the Roaring Fork Valley as you ride to the top, then hold on tight for an exhilarating ride.²



CANYON FLYER

Hop on the Canyon Flyer — *the only alpine coaster in the Colorado* — with individual cars on tracks that race 3,400 feet through the trees and down the mountainside. Firmly held on stainless steel tubular rails, the Canyon Flyer runs smoothly and silently down the mountain. The vehicles are designed to carry two visitors in comfort but can be handled easily by one alone. The riders control their speeds, which gives them a unique hands-on experience. The ride is exciting and varied, with jumps and waves built into the track to add to the thrill. Unlike an alpine slide, the Canyon Flyer makes hairpin turns and can operate year-round due to its track system.³

SWING SHOT

For the truly adventurous, the Swing Shot launches riders out over Glenwood Canyon, 1,300 feet above the Colorado River! Both the ride and the views of the Canyon are breathtaking as you soar through the air. The Swing Shot accommodates up to four riders at a time, so you can share the adrenaline rush with your friends.²

WILD TOUR

The Wild Tour is a 3-hour guided tour that explores rarely visited areas of Glenwood Caverns. This is an exciting on-your-belly and crawling experience that involves squeezing through tight sections as small as 18 inches square. Total time required is four hours to allow time to gear up and gear down before and after the tour. Protective gear and coveralls are available for rent. Reservations required.⁴

Riders less than 54” tall, but 3 years or older, can ride in the same seat with an adult, free of charge. 4) Ages 13 – 17: you can participate if accompanied by an adult 18 or older.
